Pancreatic cancer is slated to become the 2<sup>nd</sup> leading cause of cancer death by 2020. The *National Cancer Institute* spends only 1.8% of its cancer research budget on pancreatic cancer research. We want to help change these numbers.

This is **A Love For Life's** eighth year paddling in dragon boat festivals in the Philadelphia area. Dragon boating is one of our organization's most popular fundraisers. We have 4 teams (over 100 participants) ready to paddle. **A Love For Life** is one of the largest teams in the Bucks County Festival, which will be held on Saturday, September 21, 2019. We also supply our race shirts to teammates who race in 5Ks/ Marathons and bike races all across the country.

The Abramson Cancer Center at the University of Pennsylvania in Philadelphia is at the forefront of pancreatic cancer research. One hundred percent of the money we raise will go to a dedicated research team there. We do not use any portion of any donation for administrative costs, postage, or printing. Through a combination of yoga and dance classes, a tennis benefit, an Oktoberfest event, and private and corporate sponsorships, we raised over \$100,000 last year, which was presented to the Abramson Cancer Center in February.
